Next-Gen Service Provider Broadvox Rolls Out Consumer Primary Line Service to 87 Major Markets, Co-Resident with Existing Business Solution

Spring VON, SANTA CLARA, Calif., March 30, 2004 – Sylantro Systems Corporation today announced the deployment of the first hosted communications offering that allows service providers to address the consumer Voice over IP (VoIP) market and the business IP Centrex market through the same proven, carrier-class platform. Sylantro has released a new consumer broadband voice solution that allows service providers to tap into the fast-growing consumer market for VoIP services, while also serving the lucrative business IP Centrex market. Sylantro customer Broadvox, which deployed hosted communications services for business users in 2002, launched residential services in three cities in the Midwest earlier this month. Nationwide deployment is planned for 87 major markets by the end of 2004. Broadvox is the first announced Sylantro customer to deploy the consumer offering. Additional deployments of the new Sylantro consumer solution are planned by a number of major carriers in the coming months.
